The Bible

1. Ps. 46:1

¹ God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

2. II Sam. 22:31-33

- 31 As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the Lord is tried: he is a buckler to all them that trust in him.
- 32 For who is God, save the Lord? and who is a rock, save our God?

Science & Health

1. SH 559:8-12

The "still, small voice"

- of scientific thought reaches over continent and ocean to the globe's remotest bound. The inaudible voice of Truth is, to the human mind, "as when a lion roareth."
- 12 It is heard in the desert and in dark places of fear.

2. SH 287:13

God

being everywhere and all-inclusive, how can He be absent or suggest the absence of omnipresence and omnipotence? How can there be more than *all?*

3. SH 182:30

- To admit that sickness is a condition over which God has no control, is to presuppose that omnipotent power is powerless on some occasions. The law of Christ, or
- Truth, makes all things possible to Spirit; but the socalled laws of matter would render Spirit of no avail, and
- demand obedience to materialistic codes, thus departing from the basis of one God, one lawmaker. To suppose that God constitutes laws of inharmony is a mistake; dis-
- ₆ cords have no support from nature or divine law, however much is said to the contrary.

4. SH 393:4

The body seems to be self-acting, only because mortal mind is ignorant of itself, of its own actions, and of their 6 results, — ignorant that the predisposing, remote, and exciting cause of all bad effects is a law of so-called mortal mind, not of matter. Mind is the 9 master of the corporeal senses, and can conquer sickness, sin, and death. Exercise this God-given authority. Take possession of your body, and govern its feeling and action. Rise in the strength of Spirit to resist all that is unlike good. God has made man capable of this, and nothing can vitiate the ability and power divinely bestowed on man.

5. SH 378:22-28

Disease is not an intelligence to dispute the empire of Mind or to dethrone Mind and take the government into its own hands. Sickness is not a God-given, nor a self-constituted material power, which copes astutely with Mind and finally conquers it. God never endowed matter with power to disable Life or to chill harmony with a long and cold night of discord.

6. SH 192:17-21

Moral and spiritual might belong to Spirit, who holds the "wind in His fists;" and this teaching accords with Science and harmony. In Science, you can have no power opposed to God, and the physical senses must give up their false testimony.

7. SH 26:28-32

Our Master taught no mere theory, doctrine, or belief. It was the divine Principle of all real being which he 30 taught and practised. His proof of Christianity was no form or system of religion and worship, but Christian Science, working out the harmony of Life and Love.

8. SH x:11

The author has not compromised conscience to suit
the general drift of thought, but has bluntly and honestly given the text of Truth. She has made no effort
to embellish, elaborate, or treat in full detail so infinite a theme. By thousands of well-authenticated
cases of healing, she and her students have proved the
worth of her teachings. These cases for the most part
have been abandoned as hopeless by regular medical
attendants. Few invalids will turn to God till all

physical supports have failed, because there is so little faith in His disposition and power to heal disease.

9. SH 111:6-14

Christian Science is natural, but not physical. The Science of God and man is no more supernatural than is the science of numbers, though departing from the realm of the physical, as the Science of God, Spirit, must, some may deny its right to the name of Science. The Principle of divine metaphysics is God; the practice of divine metaphysics is the utilization of the power of Truth over error; its rules demonstrate its Science.

10. SH 594:1

SERPENT (ophis, in Greek; nacash, in Hebrew).
Subtlety; a lie; the opposite of Truth, named error;
the first statement of mythology and idolatry; the belief in more than one God; animal magnetism; the first lie of limitation; finity; the first claim that there is an opposite of Spirit, or good, termed matter, or evil; the first delusion that error exists as fact; the first claim that sin, sickness, and death are the realities of life. The first audible claim that God was not omnipotent and that there was another power, named evil, which was as real and eternal as God, good.

11. SH 582:17

Bridegroom. Spiritual understanding; the pure consciousness that God, the divine Principle, creates man as His own spiritual idea, and that God is the only creative power.

12. SH 275:20

Divine metaphysics, as revealed to spiritual understand11 ing, shows clearly that all is Mind, and that Mind is
12 God, omnipotence, omnipresence, omniscience,
13 Hence all is in reality the manifestation of Mind.

13. SH 285:27

As mortals reach, through knowledge of Christian Science, a higher sense, they will seek to learn, not from matter, but from the divine Principle, God, how to demonstrate the Christ, Truth, as the healing and saving power.
