Psalm 92: 1-5

- 1. It is a good thing to give thanks unto the Lord, and to sing praises unto thy name, o most High.
- 2. To shew forth thy lovingkindness in morning, and thy faithfulness every night.
- 3. Upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon the psaltery; upon harp with a solemn sound.
- 4. For, thou Lord, hast made me glad through thy work: I will triumph in the works of thy hands.
- 5. O Lord, how great are thy works! And thy thoughts are very deep.

Psalm 93:1

- 1, The Lord reigneth, he is clothed with majesty; the Lord is clothed with strength, wherewith he hath girded himself: the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved.

P. 209:31-32

Spiritual sense is a constant conscious capacity to understand God.

P. 211:1 If brain, nerves, stomach, are intelligent,-if they talk to us, tell us their condition, and report how they feel,-then Spirit and matter, Truth and error, commingle and produce sickness and health, good and evil, life and death; and who shall say whether Truth or error is the greater?

223:9-11

Remember that truth is greater than error, and we cannot put the greater into the less.

333:15-31

The advent of Jesus of Nazareth marked the first century of the Christian era, but the Christ is without beginning of years or end of days. Throughout all generations both before and after the Christian era, the Christ, as the spiritual idea,-the reflection of God,-has come with some

measure of power and grace to all prepared to receive Christ, Truth. Abraham, Jacob, Moses, and the prophets caught glorious glimpses of the Messiah, or Christ, which baptized these seers in the divine nature, the essence of Love. The divine image, idea, or Christ was, is, and ever will be inseparable from the divine Principle, God. Jesus referred to this unity of his spiritual identity thus: "Before Abraham was, Iam; "I and my Father are one," "My father is greater than I." The one Spirit includes all identities.

P.518:13

God gives the lesser idea of Himself for a link to the greater, and in return, the higher always protects the lower. The rich in spirit help the poor in one grand brotherhood, all having the same Principle, or Father; and blessed is that man who seeth his brother's need and supplieth it, seeking his own in another's good. Love giveth to the least spiritiual idea might, immortality, and goodness, which shine through all as the blossom shines through the bud. All the varied expressions of God reflect health, holiness, immortality-infinite Life, Truth, and Love.

P. 505 16-20

Spirit imparts the understanding which uplifts consciousness and leads into all truth. The Psalmist saith, "The Lord on high is mightier than the noise of many waters, yea, than the mighty waves of the sea." Spiritual sense is the discernment of spiritual good. Understanding is the line of demarcation between the real and unreal. Spiritual understanding unfolds Mind,-Life, Truth, and Love,-and demonstrates the divine sense, giving the spiritual proof of the universe in Christian Science.

This understanding is not intellectual, is not the result of scholarly attainments; it is the reality of all things brought to light. God's ideas reflect the immortal, unerring, and infinite......Understanding is a quality of God, a quality which separates Christian Science from supposition and makes Truth final.

P.89:18-21

Mind is not necessarily dependent upon educational processes. It possesses of itself all beauty and poetry, and the power of expressing them. Spirit, God, is heard when the senses are silent.

P97:22-28

It requires courage to utter truth, for the higher Truth lifts her voice, the louder will error scream, until its inarticulate sound is forever silenced into oblivion. "He uttered His voice and
